Details: Mariners are advised that **search and rescue training**, involving aerial stores delivery, will be conducted during the following periods:

- 28 July 2026 between 0830 hrs and 1130 hrs
- 29 July 2026 between 0830 hrs and 1130 hrs
- 30 July 2026 between 0830 hrs and 1130 hrs
- 31 July 2026 between 0830 hrs and 1130 hrs
- 4 August 2026 between 0830 hrs and 1130 hrs
- 5 August 2026 between 1430 hrs and 1730 hrs

Aircraft **Rescue 450 and 550** will be conducting the training in the following approximate position (reference attached chartlet):

- 38° 06' S 144° 52' E

Vessel **Bacardi** will be on location, supporting training operations and is contactable on VHF Channel 16, 12 and 6.

Search and rescue training operations (Leidos Operations) may be contacted on **08 8154 5666**.

A training beacon active on 121.4 MHz or 406 MHz may be operating in the area during the training operation.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the training operation.

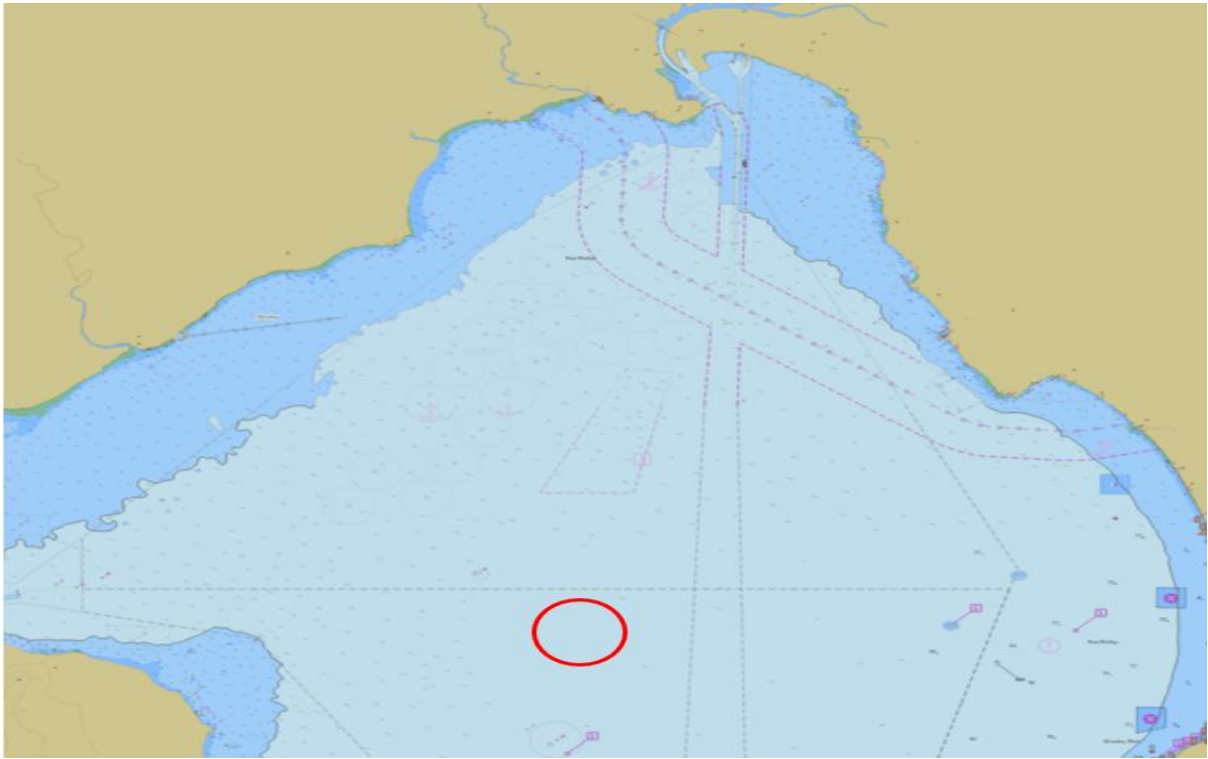
